+ How are you developing energy supply for the site?

+ Will your energy needs negatively impact my electric rates with AES?

No. We believe that local households and businesses should not have to foot the bill for data center growth. To protect your wallet, we have committed to:

- **Paying our own way:** We will cover 100% of the power we use and any new infrastructure costs required by our project.
- **Upfront costs:** We pay the direct costs for our service upfront and pay rates that reflect the full cost of serving us.
- **Independent Oversight:** Our service terms are strictly reviewed by the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC) and the Office of Utility Consumer Counselor (OUCC) to ensure the public is protected.
